- Starting authorisation: All NWKV club members possessing a valid Kendo passport are authorised. The Kendo passport has to be submitted at beginning of the event. Without submission authorisation depends on acceptance by majority of participants. The fee rises to EUR 20 per player. Players from clubs with outstanding payments of annual association fees are not authorised for starting!
The Zekken must display the last name in Latin letters. Family members have to add first name initials for distinction.

- Mode: Depending on registration numbers competition will be held in pre-pooled system followed by K.O.-system (subject to alterations):
Women will start in teams of 3 players, men in teams of 5 players.
